

FEA Events Fall 2011

Students in FEA are encouraged to attend at least SIX events a semester. Students who participate in at least NINE events and maintain a 3.0 GPA qualify for FEA Honors! Event requirements can be satisfied in the following ways:

- Attending scheduled FEA events (make sure you sign in).
- Community Service/Volunteer Hours. For every 2 hours you can receive 1 event. Up to four events a semester. Fill out the CIC volunteer/service hour log and turn it into Stephanie Heath at the End of the semester.
- Sitting on the College of Education Student Senator Advisory Council. The Student Senator meets the second Wednesday at 1:30 pm in ED 220. Come and tell her about what you think about WSU so she can take the information back to the student senate.
- Volunteering in Stephanie Heath's office working on FEA Event Prep. It takes work to make sure that the events go well for the organization, so come and Help! Each hour counts as 1 event.
