The Project Launch: Future Educators Academy grew out of the goal put forth by Weber State University, Ogden, Weber, Davis, Morgan, North Summit, and Box Elder School Districts to combat future teacher shortages and to create a teacher pipeline program to cultivate highly effective future educators.

Most of the students who participate in Project Launch come from the “Teachers of Tomorrow” Program, which is a combination of the Concurrent Enrollment class EDUC 1010 *Exploring Teaching* and participation in the Future Educators Association.

The Camp is facilitated by the Moyes College of Education and run by the Future Educators Association Professional in conjunction with community partners. Our award winning FEA Professionals participate in all aspects of the camp and act as mentors for the incoming students.

Students wishing to participate in Project Launch need to complete the registration form and pay the **\$75.00 registration fee** (less than \$20/day!). This cost covers all lodging, meals, parking, transportation and supplies. The Academy has limited space, so don't delay! Registration forms are due no later than June 1, 2012.
