BSAD 2899 and ECON 2899 are offered online, are **ZERO tuition, ZERO credit-hour** and have **course objectives** of:

- 1) Admittance to the GSBE
- 2) Assessment of student's knowledge of Business Foundation (BF) concepts

Any course having Business Foundations as a prerequisite will now have BSAD 2899 or ECON 2899 as a prerequisite as well.
