



TRIA Orthopaedic Center Summer Sports Medicine Internship

Goal:

To immerse the student into the sports medicine practice of a large state of the science orthopaedic center.

Objective:

The student will observe all aspects of the sports medicine practice: clinical evaluation and diagnosis, imaging techniques and therapies, surgical procedures, rehabilitation and physical therapy, and be included in continuing education of medical students, residents and orthopaedic fellows.

Rotations:

The student will rotate through the following areas – Clinic with physicians (2 weeks), Radiology (1 week), Surgery (2 weeks), Physical Therapy (2 weeks) and the Acute Injury Clinic (1 or 2 week(s))

These rotations are observational with no patient care responsibilities. This is an unpaid internship. The internship will run from approx. June 1 – August 1.

Requirements:

Two Students will be selected from all candidates. They must have completed, at minimum, their sophomore year in college. They will provide their own housing and transportation to and from the internship site (TRIA Orthopaedic Center). They must be able to demonstrate knowledge and interest in the sports medicine field.

This allows for a better internship experience. These internships will be designed for the individual and based on his or her areas of interest. All internships are unpaid.

The summer internship program is a competitive program that allows for immersion into the orthopaedic setting. Rotations into all areas of the clinic will be scheduled. There will be only two interns selected for the summer, with the internship running from approximately June 1 – August 1. The interns will not be in the same areas at the same time to allow for one on one interaction with physicians and sports medicine specialists. The summer interns will be selected from a pool of applicants. The application process will include the completion of an application form and then the top candidates will be interviewed with two selected.
