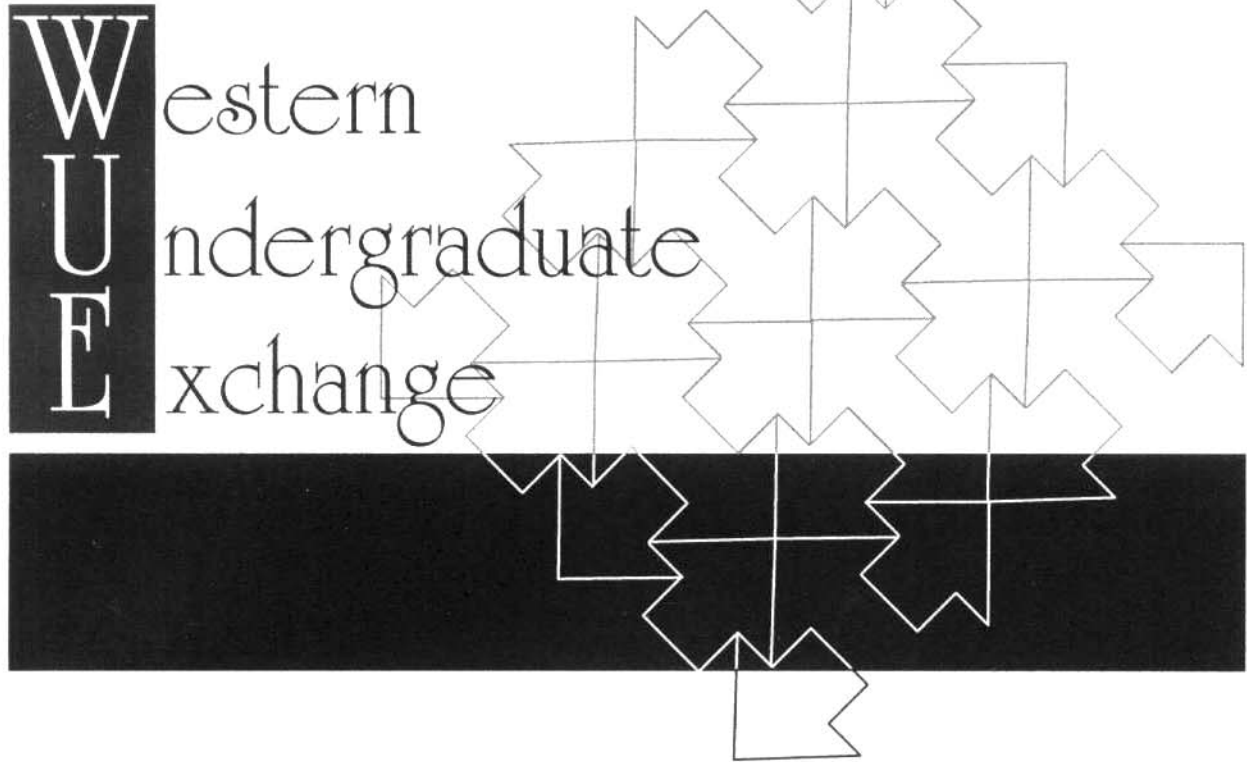

WESTERN UNDERGRADUATE EXCHANGE PROGRAM  
POLICIES AND PROCEDURES\***

1. Certain majors are restricted, at present all majors in Teacher Education, Nursing and Dental Hygiene are not available for WUE status. All other major programs are accepted for WUE status.
2. Students must apply by the deadline and also must have completed the admission process, including the submission of all transcripts and ACT scores. Admission to the university does not constitute acceptance into the WUE program.
3. WUE participants must register for and complete a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester, must maintain good academic standing, and must remain in the academic major under which admitted. WUE recipients who “stop out” for a semester without the permission of the Scholarship Office must reapply and meet selection criteria for any available WUE awards the following academic year.
4. Deferring use of a WUE scholarship for an extended leave of absence is not allowed.
5. WUE status must be renewed yearly by the Weber State University Scholarship Office. **Written notice of your intention to continue on WUE status must be received by April 1 each year or the tuition reduction will be awarded elsewhere.** Students may renew their WUE award for a maximum of 8 semesters. Form available in Scholarship Office
6. **Time spent in the WUE program may not subsequently be counted toward the student’s residency requirement.**
7. The program is not designed for students who are already attending Weber State University, although exceptions may be made where space is available in the program by: (1) permission of the Scholarship Committee, and, where applicable, the State Certifying Office; (2) meeting application and selection criteria for any available WUE awards.
8. Selection for participation in the program is on a space-available basis. Only a finite number of such waivers are available within an academic year.

**POLICIES AND PROCEDURES**

1. Certain majors are restricted, at present all majors in Teacher Education, Nursing and Dental Hygiene are not available for WUE status. All other major programs are accepted for WUE status.
2. Students must apply by the deadline and also must have completed the admission process, including the submission of all transcripts and ACT scores. Admission to the university does not constitute acceptance into the WUE program.
3. WUE participants must register for and complete a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester, must maintain a 2.00 cumulative grade point average, and must remain in the academic major under which admitted. WUE recipients who "stop out" for a semester without the permission of the Scholarship Office must reapply and meet selection criteria for any available WUE awards the following academic year.
4. Deferring use of a WUE scholarship for an extended leave of absence is not allowed.
5. WUE status must be renewed yearly by the Weber State University Scholarship Office. (Written notice of your intention to continued on WUE status must be received by May 1 each year or the tuition reduction will be awarded elsewhere.) Students may renew their WUE award for a maximum of 8 semesters.
6. Time spent in the WUE program may not subsequently be counted toward the student's residency requirement.
7. The program is not designed for students who are already attending Weber State University, although exceptions may be made where space is available in the program by: (1) permission of the Scholarship Office, and, where applicable, the State Certifying Office; (2) meeting application and selection criteria for any available WUE awards.
8. Selection for participation in the program is on a space available basis, only a finite number of such waivers are available within an academic year.
9. Students from any participating state are given WUE tuition status only in degree programs at the level or levels in which his/her home state offers programs to WUE students from other states. Please check with the State Certifying Office in your state before applying.
