

Club Sport Council
Constitution
2008-2009 (revised 10-14-08)

1. Board Members

- a. The committee will consist of Six members
 - i. Three students, one faculty, and two staff members from Campus Recreation.
 - ii. Student members will consist of three students from three different club sport teams.
 - iii. Students may serve two terms (academic year is one term). Two candidates will be voted on by the staff members of the council to serve two terms for consistency.
 - iv. The other one student will be required to be re-elected at the Club Leadership monthly meeting in February.
 - v. Voting Members: Three students, Faculty member, one staff member from Campus Recreation (Assistant Director of Campus Recreation will not be a voting member).

2. Election

- a. The first election will be held on the first Tuesday of February at the clubs meeting
- b. Each club may submit one student member to run for election
 - i. Prior to the first Tuesday in February, names will be submitted to the Council by the leaders of each club.
 - ii. Each candidate will be given 3 minutes to represent themselves.
 - iii. Election will be taken at that time and counted to assure no ties. If there is a tie, the top person will be removed and a revote taken.
 - iv. The top five candidates will be asked to represent themselves at the March meeting.
 - v. Election for the two positions will be taken and announced during the March meeting.
 - vi. New members will begin their service in July

3. Student Membership Requirements

- a. Student must have been an active member of a club sport team, and in good standing, for two semesters
- b. Must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5
- c. Must attend all committee meetings. If two meetings are missed in a semester, the Director will replace the student next semester at their discretion
- d. Will need to represent the club sports program, not just their own club
- e. Student will receive a ½ tuition waiver paid at ½ the amount for each semester served (ie. \$600/Fall, \$600/Spring) at the beginning of the semester
- f. Student may offer their waiver to any qualifying club member of their choice if they do not need the waiver

4. Club Committee Responsibilities

- a. Impartially represent the club sports program and not their club
- b. Distribute SFA funding
- c. Distribute SFA waivers
- d. Distribute National's Travel Account funds
- e. Recommend judiciary action for clubs who fail to follow policy
- f. Review club policies, fines, incidents, and grievances
- g. Respond to all urgent petitions in a timely manner
- h. Maintain strict confidentiality of council discussions
