Emerging Leader Tuition Waiver

The Weber State University Department of Student Involvement & Leadership seeks to build students through active involvement and leadership opportunities. This goal is met by providing leadership growth opportunities in the community and on campus. The Emerging Leaders program is an organization that helps the chosen applicants develop their skills to become more effective contributors to Weber State, the community, and within personal relationships. The accompanying tuition waiver is awarded based on participation in the program. This waiver is only for the chosen year and cannot be deferred for later semesters.

Eligibility Requirements

- To be eligible, an applicant must:
 1. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale
 2. Exhibit past involvement with school and/or community activities, with particular experience in leadership roles.
 3. Be a U.S. resident.
 4. Be accepted to Weber State University and committed to attending in both the Fall and Spring Semesters of next academic year.
 5. Successfully participate in the Emerging Leaders program as established by the Department of Student Involvement & Leadership. (See below)
- Selection of Emerging Leaders will be based on scholastic achievement, extracurricular involvement, community involvement, and leadership experience. Financial need will not be considered.
- Emerging Leaders Scholarships are awarded on an annual basis and are open to students of Weber State University who will be freshmen or sophomores in the upcoming (2019-20) school year.
- In order to maintain the scholarship throughout the year, recipients will be expected to successfully complete the Emerging Leadership Program. Participation includes bi-weekly classes on Thursday from 2:30-4:30pm, attendance at Project LEAD Leadership Conference (February 2020), reading of leadership materials, and work in a group to create programs and community service opportunities.

Scholarship Requirements

1. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale

3. Be accepted to Weber State University and will be attending in the next Fall and Spring Semesters.
4. Successfully participate in the Emerging Leaders program as established by the Department of Student Involvement & Leadership.
