EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION FOR LICENSED ELEMENTARY TEACHERS

UTAH POLICY STATEMENT

The following is adopted as an alternative procedure to permit licensed elementary teachers to qualify for an Early Childhood Licensure.

- 1. The candidate for Early Childhood Licensure shall hold a current Elementary Licensure. (Preferably with primary elementary experience.)
- 2. The candidate shall complete an approved program of early childhood education at an accredited institution of higher education. The approved program will include:
