

What do you need to bring for the application process to do your Student Teaching?

<u>Student Teaching Application</u> (print a hard copy of this application)	<p>After your application has been submitted online you must come into the Student Teaching Office in ED 230B and sign up for an interview. See the web page for dates applications are accepted.</p> <p>Please bring your printed application and all other applicable, required documentation from the list below to sign up for an interview time. An interview must be scheduled on or before the Student Teaching deadline in ED 230B.</p> <p><i>Please Note: The application also applies to the Master of Education Students completing their Practicum or Student Teaching.</i></p>
<u>Autobiography - Max 1 page</u> (4 copies)	<p>This autobiography is an introduction to the Cooperating Teacher(s) and University Supervisor(s). The autobiography may include family background, education, work, travel, interests and talents highlighting skills that could be utilized in your teaching, and your reasons for choosing the teaching profession (<u>This is not a resume</u>).</p>
<u>ESL Form – (ESL Students Only)</u> <u>Support Course Requirement Form</u>	<p>Signed by Dr. Byrd</p> <p>Secondary Students only; not required for Master of Education Students</p>
<u>Student Teaching Reciprocity Form</u>	<p>For those requesting remote placement only</p>
<u>Verification Of Completion Form</u> (complete the applicable form)	<p><u>Student Teaching</u> (Secondary Education Students Only) (2 copies)</p> <p><u>MEd Student Teaching</u> (for Med Student Teachers)</p> <p><u>MEd Practicum</u> (for MEd Practicum students)</p>
<u>Student Teaching Intern License</u>	<p>access on the USOE Website</p>
<u>Your Unofficial Transcript</u>	<p>an unofficial copy can be obtained through your Student Portal or Cat Tracks</p>
<u>Interactive Student Teaching Guidebook</u>	<p>View and complete the questions for each chapter. Please print a hard copy of your summary score page and a hard copy of the <u>Student Teaching Guidebook</u> and bring with you when you sign up for an interview.</p>
<u>Praxis Test Results</u>	<p>You must include a complete copy, including subtest scores, of your Praxis II results in your application packet. If this is not available at the time of application, you must provide a copy of the Praxis II receipt with your name evident as proof you have registered to take it in the future.</p> <p><u>It is strongly recommended that all Praxis II tests be taken and passed prior to student teaching.</u></p>
<p>Please be advised that you may <u>not sign up for a student teaching interview</u> until you have completed each item listed below. Bring a hard copy of applicable items with you when you sign up for your interview time in ED 230B.</p> <p><u>**Remember that if you miss the student teaching application deadline, you will be not be placed for student teaching until the following semester.</u></p>
