WEBER STATE UNIVERSITY EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION FOR LICENSED ELEMENTARY TEACHERS

POLICY STATEMENT

The following is adopted as an alternative procedure to permit licensed elementary teachers to qualify for an Early Childhood Licensure.

1. The candidate for Early Childhood Licensure shall hold a current Elementary Licensure. (Preferably with primary elementary experience.)
