Highlights

- Revision of mission statement, college and department goals to nest within the university mission and goals
- Updated program assessment plans, curriculum grids, student outcomes, and assessment results have been posted on the university assessment website
- Successful completion of seven faculty searches
- Faculty training for designing and developing online courses
- Hiring of a full time college recruiter to work with all departments and programs to implement community/university recruiting activities and programs.



Highlights, Con't

- Athletic Training Masters Degree approved
- WSU – College of Education selected as the host for the 2009 International Society for Teacher Education seminar.
- Provided \$90,000 for new and upgraded technology in faculty offices, labs, and classrooms
- Revision of college tenure document nearly complete
- Completion of emergency evacuation plan



College Goals for 2008/2009

- Support faculty research and scholarship by funding a writing support group and training for grant writing.
- Finish revisions to and obtain approval for the college tenure document.
- Support efforts towards:
 - Successful national accreditation of the Athletic Training program.
 - Successful completion of program reviews for four college programs.
 - Collaborate with Departments in the development of a long range plan for delivery of programs and courses at WWSU Davis.



Tenure Document Revision Projected Timeline

- August 19 thru September 15 – Faculty input to Dean and final revisions
- September 30, 2008 - Approved by College Faculty (email vote)
- October 31, 2008 – Approved by Appointment, Promotion, Academic Freedom, & Tenure Committee
- November 30, 2008 – Approved by Faculty Senate
