Selection Criteria

An applicant for this scholarship must

- be a major in the college of science
- have at least 60 credit hours at the beginning of the 2009 fall semester
- a full-time student during the period when the scholarship is in effect
- include a current copy of his/her transcript and a **brief** written statement (one page or less) that addresses why he/she qualifies for this scholarship and how it will help him/her to achieve his/her educational goals at Weber State University
- **update his/her personal information with the WSU Scholarship Office by January 12, 2009** to be eligible to receive any WSU scholarship; do this by going online and following the link on <http://weber.edu/scholarships/continuingsscholarships.html> /

In addition, the following specific criteria will be used to determine Truman W. & Selma Swenson Nilson Science recipients (criteria not necessarily listed in order of their importance):

- **In honor of Gilbert C. Barton, Ph.D.** To be awarded to a student who has lost a parent or other close family member to illness or injury.
- **In honor of J. Ronald Galli, Ph.D.** To be awarded to a promising student who has surmounted significant challenges and/or disabilities.
- **In honor of David S. Havertz, Ph.D.** To be awarded to a pre-medical student giving service in the premedical honor society or other community medical service.
- **In honor of Homer R. Rich, M.D.** To be awarded to a student electing to become a pediatrician or a pediatric nurse.

In addition to the above stated requirements, an applicant must

- include one **brief** letter of recommendation (one page or less) that address in what way he/she satisfies the specific criteria for the scholarship
