### The Eugene M. Hall Pre-pharmacy Scholarship

#### Selection Criteria

An applicant for this scholarship must

- be a major in the college of science
- have at least 60 credit hours at the beginning of the 2010 fall semester
- be a full-time student during the period when the scholarship is in effect
- include a current copy of his/her transcript and a **brief** written statement (one page or less) that addresses why he/she qualifies for this scholarship and how it will help him/her to achieve his/her educational goals at Weber State University
- **update his/her personal information with the WSU Scholarship Office by January 11, 2010** to be eligible to receive any WSU scholarship; do this by going online and following the link on <http://weber.edu/scholarships/continuing-scholarships.html> /

In addition, the following criteria will be used to determine Eugene M. Hall Pre-Pharmacy Scholarship recipients (criteria not necessarily listed in order of their importance):

1. Evidence of working toward acceptance into pharmacy school
2. Preference will be given to applicants who are actively involved in community service
3. Preference will be given to applicants who possess a speaking knowledge of a foreign language (Spanish is preferred)
4. Minimum GPA of 3.0
5. Preference will be given to applicants who demonstrate financial need

In addition to the above stated requirements, an applicant must

- include one **brief** letter of recommendation (one page or less) that addresses in what way he/she satisfies the second and/or third criterion (involvement in community service and foreign language skill)
- provide evidence that he/she is actively working towards pursuing a pharmacy degree (You can do this by either having the pre-pharmacy advisor sign below, or by including a copy of a letter of acceptance to a pharmacy program.)

The applicant is known to me as working actively toward a degree in pharmacy.
