College of Science The Rulon F. & Margaret C. Howe Memorial Scholarship

Selection Criteria

An applicant for this scholarship must

- be a major in the college of science
- have at least 60 credit hours at the beginning of the 2010 fall semester
- be a full-time student during the period when the scholarship is in effect
- include a current copy of his/her transcript and a **brief** written statement (one page or less) that addresses why he/she qualifies for this scholarship and how it will help him/her to achieve his/her educational goals at Weber State University
- **update his/her personal information with the WSU Scholarship Office by January 11, 2010** to be eligible to receive any WSU scholarship; do this by going online and following the link on <http://weber.edu/scholarships/continuing-scholarships.html> /

In addition, the following criteria will be used to determine Rulon F. & Margaret C. Howe Memorial Scholarship recipients (criteria not necessarily listed in order of their importance):

1. Evidence of working toward acceptance into medical school
2. Competitive GPA for medical school admission
3. solid background in physics, chemistry, biological sciences, and mathematics
4. Interest in biological/medical research as evidenced by presentations of special projects, papers submitted to journals, presentations to professional groups, etc.
5. Evidence that the applicant has skills in working with people under a variety of work/volunteer circumstances

In addition to the above stated requirements, an applicant must

- include 1-2 **brief** letters of recommendation (one page or less) that address in what way he/she satisfies the fourth and/or fifth criterion (research and volunteer work)
- provide evidence that he/she is actively working toward acceptance into medical school (do this by having the med-medical advisor sign below, or by providing a letter of acceptance to a medical school program)

The applicant is known to me as working actively toward acceptance into medical school.
