Registering with the Community Involvement Center

- Access the registration form at www.weber.edu/CommunityInvolvement, the Community Involvement Center home page.
- Click on 'Register' in the student bubble at the bottom of the page.
- Fill out the registration form **completely and accurately**. You will receive a confirmation page and a confirmation email when your registration is complete.

- Maintain Service Opportunity Directory (list of over 100 community partners).
- Record and track completed service hours.
- Communicate completed service hours to instructors at three separate times during semester: at the end of 5, 10 and 15 weeks.
- Documentation of service, upon request, for potential employers and/or graduate programs.
