Tutors CAN:

1. Review and explain assignments, outlines, and course objectives.
2. Clarify information presented by the instructor.
3. Help you understand the textbook and how to use it.
4. Help you develop learning skills and strategies.

Tutors CANNOT:

1. Complete assignments (math problems, term papers, etc.) for you.
2. Teach material you have not read or heard in class.

Policies:

1. Read and sign a tutoring *contract* at your first session.
2. To cancel a session, contact your tutor using the method agreed upon (phone or email) **at least 24 hours in advance**. If you cannot reach your tutor directly you may call the *Davis Learning Center* at 395-3524 or 395-3539 and leave a message.
3. Tutoring can be terminated after two "no-shows" or three cancellations.
