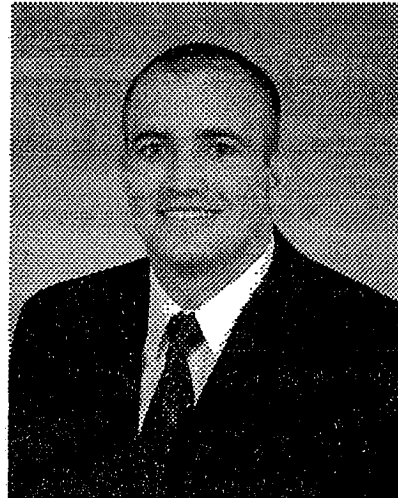


**Kenny Morris, Director

Kenny Morris is the Director of Environmental Safety and Emergency Management for Baylor Health Care System's Dallas Campus, which includes Baylor University Medical Center, Baylor Heart and Vascular Hospital, Baylor Institute for Rehabilitation, Baylor Specialty Hospital, and Our Children's House.
