

Online Access | Temporary Prescription Card

HOW TO DOWNLOAD AN ONLINE TEMPORARY PRESCRIPTION CARD

STEP 1: Go to www.medco.com. You can access a temporary prescription card two ways. You can sign in using your member ID and date of birth (Steps 2-3), or via an online account (Steps 4-6).

STEP 2: If you don't want to create an account, click on the "Forms & cards" link located among the list of links below the main image.



STEP 3: On the next page, click on "Request Forms and cards now" in the orange box. From there, enter your ID and DOB and skip to Step 7.

STEP 4: If you have an account or would like to create one, go to www.medco.com and select the "Login" link or create an online account by clicking on "Register now."



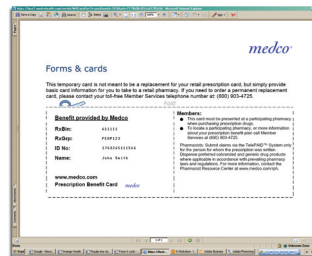
STEP 5: From the login page, enter your registered e-mail address and password.

STEP 6: A page showing your current account summary is loaded. From here click on the "Forms & cards" link.



STEP 7: From the bottom of the "Forms & Cards" page click "Print a temporary prescription card."

STEP 8: This takes you to a page that says "Print a temporary prescription card." Click on the "Print Card" button.



STEP 7: A PDF file of the Temporary prescription card will load.

Now, print.

You must be enrolled at Medco in order to print a temporary card. The temporary card will not have some information contained on the permanent card (e.g. medical copays and claim address, etc). Members who do not have Internet access, may call Medco Health at 800-903-4725 to request a new card if they do not receive their card within 10 days after the eligibility has been forwarded to PEHP.
