If you did not attend the scholarship auditions, you need to take the Theory Placement Test in the **Browning Center room 322** on one of the following dates:

**Saturday May 5th, 2012 10:00 AM -- 12:00 PM**

**Saturday June 2nd, 2012 10:00 AM -- 12:00 PM**

**Friday August 24th, 2012 8:00 AM -- 4:00 PM**

Select **one** of the following combinations (if placed in Music Theory I):

Select **one** of the following piano courses (required):

MUSC 1150 Class Piano I TR 11:30 – 12:20 p.m. 1 credit hour CRN: **20604**

MUSC 1150 Class Piano I WF 11:30 – 12:20 p.m. 1 credit hour CRN: **20605**

MUSC 1150 Class Piano I TR 8:30 – 9:20 a.m. 1 credit hour CRN: **20606**

Select appropriate Master class (by instrument): **MUSC 1502 through MUSC 1544** 1 cr. hour

Select appropriate Applied Lesson (by instrument): **MUSC 1610 through MUSC 1660** 1 credit hour

\*Day and time of applied lesson arranged through the Performing Arts office – must be registered first\*

Select appropriate Ensemble (by instrument): **MUSC 1730 through 1763** 1 credit hour

**MUSC 1901 Music-the 1<sup>st</sup> Year Exp. TR 10:30 – 11:20 a.m. 1 credit hour CRN: 26022**

Select **2 general education courses – preferably English and Math based on ACT/Accuplacer scores**

ACT: English AND Reading scores 29 or higher – register for ENGL 2010

English AND Reading scores 17 – 28 – register for ENGL 1010

English AND/OR Reading scores 13 – 16 register for ENGL 0955 (or take Accuplacer for placement)

English AND/OR Reading scores 12 or lower – register for ENGL 0900 (or take Accuplacer for placement)

Math score of 23 or higher – register for one of the following: Math 1030, Math 1040 or Math 1050

Math score of 22 or below – Must take Accuplacer for math placement.

Accuplacer:

Reading Comprehension AND Sentence Skills: scores of 90 or higher – register for ENGL 1010

Reading Comprehension AND/OR Sentence Skills: scores of 40 – 89 – register for ENGL 0955

Reading Comprehension AND/OR Sentence Skills: scores of 30 or below – register for ENGL 0900

Arithmetic – score of 20 – 74 – register for Math 0950

Arithmetic – score of 75 or higher AND Elementary Algebra – score of 0-54 – register for Math 0990

Elementary Algebra – score of 55 or higher AND College Level Math – score of 0 – 49 – register for MATH 1010

College Level Math – score of 50 - 69 – register for ONE: Math 1030, Math 1040, or Math 1050

College Level Math – score of 70 or higher – Fulfills the Quantitative Literacy requirement – course not required.
