Emerging Leader Scholarship

The Department of Student Involvement & Leadership seeks to promote active involvement on campus, and cultivation of leadership skills for Weber State University students. To this ends, we offer the Emerging Leaders Scholarship. Selection into this program provides incoming students with a monetary scholarship and an understanding about leadership that goes above and beyond the average experience at Weber State University.

Eligibility Requirements

- To be eligible, an applicant must:
 1. Have a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or higher on a 4.0 scale
 2. ACT of 20 or greater, or a SAT of 950 or greater.
 3. Exhibit involvement in high school and community activities, with particular experience in leadership roles.
 4. Be accepted to Weber State University and committed to attending in the Fall Semester of 2009.
 5. Successfully participate in the Emerging Leaders program as established by the Department of Student Involvement & Leadership.
- Selection of Emerging Leaders will be based on scholastic achievement, extracurricular involvement, community involvement, and leadership experience. Financial need will not be considered.
- Emerging Leaders Scholarships are awarded on an annual basis and is open to current and future students who will be attending Weber State University the Fall Semester of 2010 from the state of Utah.
- In order to maintain the scholarship, recipients will be expected to successfully complete the Emerging Leadership Program. Participation includes bi-weekly classes on Thursday evening from 4-6pm, and work in a group to create programs and community service opportunities for the entire campus.
- Over 90% of Emerging Leaders move on to leadership roles with the campus and are able to continue the same level of financial support throughout their WSU career.

The Emerging Leaders Program is designed to recognize high school seniors who have excelled in a variety of leadership capacities both at high school and in their community.

Scholarship Requirements

1. Have a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or higher on a 4.0 scale
2. ACT of 20 or greater, or a SAT of 950 or greater.
3. Exhibit involvement in high school and community activities, with particular experience in leadership roles within the state of Utah. *(Only Utah residents are eligible.)*
4. Be accepted to Weber State University and will be attending in the Fall Semester of 2010.
5. Successfully participate in the Emerging Leaders program as established by the Department of Student Involvement & Leadership.
