#### **FEDERAL STUDENT AID PROGRAM**

\*Federal and state grants \* Low-interest loans \* Part-time employment (college work-study) \* Fill out only one application and the WSU Financial Aid Office will assist you in getting any aid for which you qualify. Repayment of the loan portion does not begin until six months after graduation, withdrawal from school, or registration for less than six credit hours.

#### **TUITION-BY-10 MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN**

\*Spread the cost of a full year's tuition over 10 monthly payments. For example: If your yearly tuition bill was \$2,000, you would pay \$200/month for 10 months. It's interest free and requires a \$60 application fee. Available through KeyBank USA. Call KeyBank at 1-800-KEY-LEND for details. To take advantage of WSUs monthly payment plan at other times of the year, contact KeyBank.

#### **INSTITUTIONAL SHORT-TERM LOAN PROGRAM**

\*Requires a good credit history \* Interest free if loan is repaid within 90 days \* Requires \$20 setup fee \*Payment is due 90 days after receipt of the loan. Available funds are limited.
