These scholarships are intended to recognize and assist deserving students in the 2-year Automotive Service Technology programs (ATEP (Independent program), BSEP (Collision Program), DaimlerChrysler CAP, General Motors ASEP, Honda PACT, or Toyota T-TEN) at Weber State University. The recipients will be awarded \$1,000 to be applied toward tuition, fees, books, and/or on-campus housing. No other expenses of any kind are to be paid with this scholarship. If an award recipient transfers out of the program during the award period or is enrolled for less than full-time credit, the recipient will relinquish all rights to the balance of the award.

Applicants must attach:

1. A brief typewritten essay describing accomplishments while at WSU, how their degree in Automotive Service Technology will be used after graduation, and why they believe they're deserving of the scholarship.
2. A brief statement and/or documentation about financial resources, including a list of other scholarships and tuition waivers being received (say no other scholarships or waivers if that is the case).
3. A copy of the most recent WSU transcript.

Applicants must be enrolled in WSU at the time of application.

Applicants must be enrolled as a 2-year Automotive Service Technology program (ATEP (Independent program), BSEP (Collision Program) Chrysler CAP, General Motors ASEP, Honda PACT, or Toyota T-TEN) major and express intent to earn an Associate of Applied Science Degree in the one of these programs.

Applicants will be judged on:

- * perceived potential for success in the field of automotive service.
- * excellence of academic record (minimum GPA of 3.0).
- * financial need.

I understand that this is not a scholarship offer, but only an application to be considered in scholarship competition if minimum qualifications for the award have been satisfied. I understand that withholding requested information or falsification of this information may result in denial or loss of scholarship.
