

Early College Eligibility Requirements & Scholarships

To be eligible to participate in Early College, you must be a high school sophomore, junior, or senior. Sophomores must have an index score of at least 110 and will be limited in their registration. Juniors and seniors must have an index score of at least 100. Scholarships are available to help off-set or even cover tuition and student fees for eligible students. Early College scholarships are available only to admitted Early College students for fall and spring semesters.

Need-Based Scholarships

Based on essay and evidence of financial need. Need-based scholarship applications are accepted up to 3 weeks before the semester begins.

Academic Scholarships

Based on index score (ACT/SAT score + GPA)

- Presidential Scholarship - Full tuition and fees
Index score of 128 or above
- High Honors Scholarship** - 50% of tuition
Index score of 120 to 127
- Honors Scholarship** - 30% of tuition
Index score of 115 to 119
- Achievement Scholarship - 15% of tuition
Index score of 105 to 114
- Admissions Requirement for 10th Graders
- Admissions Requirement for 11th and 12th Graders

** Students at these scholarship levels are required to take at least six WSU credit hours each semester. Students eligible for these scholarship levels who take less than six credit hours will be awarded the Achievement Scholarship.
