### **Course Requirements for B.S. or B.A. Degree in Geography with Global Studies Emphasis (36 credit hours)**

#### ***Required Core Courses (12 credits)***

- GEOG PS/SI 1000 Natural Environments of the Earth (3)
- GEOG SS 1300 People and Places of the World (3)
- GEOG SI 4050 Quantitative Methods in Geography (3)
- GEOG SI 4990 Research Seminar (3)

#### ***Required Regional Courses (12 credits)***

Select four of the following, including one course in a non-western or third world region.

- GEOG SS 1520 Geography of the U.S. and Canada (3)
- GEOG 3500 Geography of Utah (3)
- GEOG 3540 Geography of Latin America (3)
- GEOG 3590 Geography of Europe (3)
- GEOG 3620 Geography of Russia and the former USSR (3)
- GEOG 3640 Geography of Asia (3)
- GEOG 3660 Geography of China and Japan (3)
- GEOG 3740 Geography of Africa (3)
- GEOG 3780 Geography Area Studies (1-3)

#### ***Required Technique Courses (3 credits)***

Select one of the following

- GEOG 3460 Advanced Cartography (3)

#### ***Additional Upper Division Courses (9credits)***

Students must take 9 additional credits in Geography. These may be environmental, cultural, regional, or technique courses. Support courses in related fields that emphasize global or regional studies are encouraged.
