LOTTERY UPDATE

We are pleased to announce that the “A” parking permit lottery was successfully completed. Approximately 500 seniors entered the lottery which resulted in all “A” permits being sold out. There will not be a lottery for underclassmen. Seniors can log on to the system to determine if they were selected in the lottery by selecting the “Pay for Permit” link. If you were selected, the link will display the permit you received and will prompt you to complete the purchase. As a reminder, all lottery permits must be paid for by August 3rd. After your payment is posted you may pick up your permit at Parking Services, Annex 5, M-F, 6:30am - 4:30pm. (ID required)

Please note that the payment system will be unavailable on July 26-27 to allow for a system upgrade.

“A” Permits:

Any “A” permit that is not paid for or that is returned will be made available to any student regardless of class standing on a first come first serve basis. As these permits become available we will sell them from the following web site:

“W” “RW” and “Dee Center Permits”

Any student wishing to purchase “W” “RW” and “Dee Center” permits can begin making those purchases on Wednesday, August 5th. Please follow the instructions below to access the system and make that purchase.

To access the Parking Services web applications each person must log into their e-Weber account. This can be done from the Weber State homepage. After logging in, please click on the Student Services tab. Our channel default location is in the bottom left hand corner of the page. You will register for your permit and then pay for your permit. Once the permit has been paid for you may come to Parking Services to pick it up. Permits are not mailed out.

Parking Citations:

Parking Rules and Regulations require that all citations must be paid prior to permit purchases. Any attempt to access the system for an account with unpaid citations will be prevented. Outstanding citations can be reviewed by clicking on that link. To pay the citations listed, click on the “Pay Citations Now” link found on the page or go to the Parking Services home page <http://departments.weber.edu/parking>. Citation payments are posted to accounts within one business day. For immediate payment processing, please come to Parking Services located in Annex 5.
