Diversity Clarification



The question was recently raised regarding whether or not the Diversity requirement is considered satisfied by a less than 3 credit hour class. According to the Registrar's Office, students may submit a petition to waive up to 1 credit hour of Diversity *if* the credit hour shortage is due to the quarter/semester conversion, transfer work, etc. However, Diversity will not be waived for experience such as a foreign mission, study abroad, etc., nor by taking a class less than 3 credit hours!

Students who fall into this category should contact the Registrar's Office at 626-6046 for more information on submitting an "Exception to University Policy" petition.

"Degree Eval" Webpage

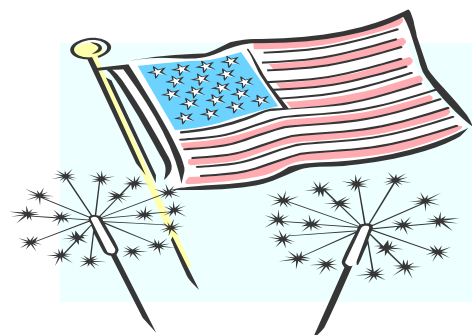
