CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT SENIORS: STATUS SWITCH

1. Log in to eWeber student portal at weber.edu/eweber.

High school students may apply beginning **Sept. 1** of their senior year. Students who have completed any Weber State Concurrent Enrollment classes during high school do not need to reapply for admission (see *Status Switch*).

STEP 1: FILL OUT THE APPLICATION ONLINE

- A. Official high school transcript.
- B. ACT/SAT scores (not required for admission but used for scholarships & placement).
- C. Official college transcripts if applicable (including Concurrent Enrollment).
