Application Information

1. For a fall semester start: January 15 application becomes available with a March 30 application deadline for those that would like join each fall semester. The 2 semester certificate only starts in the fall and is a total 2 semesters (fall and spring).

Program Information

- · Intended for nursing professionals seeking an opportunity for additional which is offered over a full semester
- Courses offered over 2 semesters, 7-week block program with exception of Residency exposure to nursing administration or nursing education
- 100% online delivery format for theory/didactic courses
- WSU School of Nursing Certificate will be awarded upon completion of all required
- Optional 90-hour supervised residency in the area of focus in your local graduate level courses as a stand-alone certificate community requiring face-to-face contact hours
- · Cohort start is based on administrative approval, funding, and a minimum number of qualified applicants

Application Requirements:

- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) for all college level course work
- Earned MS degree (or higher) with a major in nursing from an accredited nursing program (ACEN, CCNE, or CNEA) and from a regionally accredited college or university
- Current unencumbered license to practice as a registered nurse or eligible to obtain licensure without restrictions to practice as a registered nurse in your state. Must be an RN in your state of residence prior starting the program beginning.
- Submission of all documents, curriculum vitae/resume, and goal statement in the online application system
