1. The meeting convened at $8 \mathrm{a} . \mathrm{m}$.
2. President's Council members approved April 26, 2017, meeting minutes with corrections.
3. The President's Council discussed how a planned expansion at the Northern Utah Academy for Math, Engineering and Science (NUAMES) could impact WSU scholarships to the high school.
4. Brad Mortensen, vice president for University Advancement, asked for short-term oversight of WSU's parade float over the summer. He also mentioned that his office was determining a location for the 2017 summer picnic.
