Minutes

2. President's Council members approved minutes for the May 30, 2018, meeting.

PPM Changes: 5-36a, 6-22, 3-67, 3-32, PPM Eliminations: 6-16, 3-1 3. Stephanie Hollist, deputy general counsel; Barry Gomberg, executive director of the Office of Affirmative Action and Equal Opportunity; and Dane LeBlanc, chief of police; discussed several proposed changes to policies that pertain to due process and safety at the university. Changes to definitions and how policy addresses violence or threats of violence were among the proposed changes.

## **ACTION**

After discussion, the President's Council approved changes to PPMs 5-36 a, 3-32, 6-22, 3-67 (contingent upon discussion with ASSA chairs), and the elimination of PPMs 6-16 and 3-1. Changes and eliminations would go to the WSU Board of Trustees for final approval.

4. Provost Madonne Miner proposed a pilot for the use of the Curriculog process system as a way to track changes to PPMs. The pilot would apply to PPM changes that go through Faculty Senate.

## **ACTION**

5. Miner proposed the creation of quasi-endowment within the School of Nursing that would support ongoing efforts to accommodate more nursing students. The \$100,000 to start the endowment would come from a FY '18 budget balance.

USHE Digital Literacy Pilot.

6. Miner discussed a plan to fund a study regarding digital literacy with one-time money. Interim President Norm Tarbox recommended that the study be conducted appropriately in order to be of use to the university.

7. Assistant Vice President for Diversity and Chief Diversity Officer Adrienne Andrews shared fall diversity events with the President's Council.

8. Shane Farver, chief of staff for the Office of the President, shared upcoming events of the summer.
