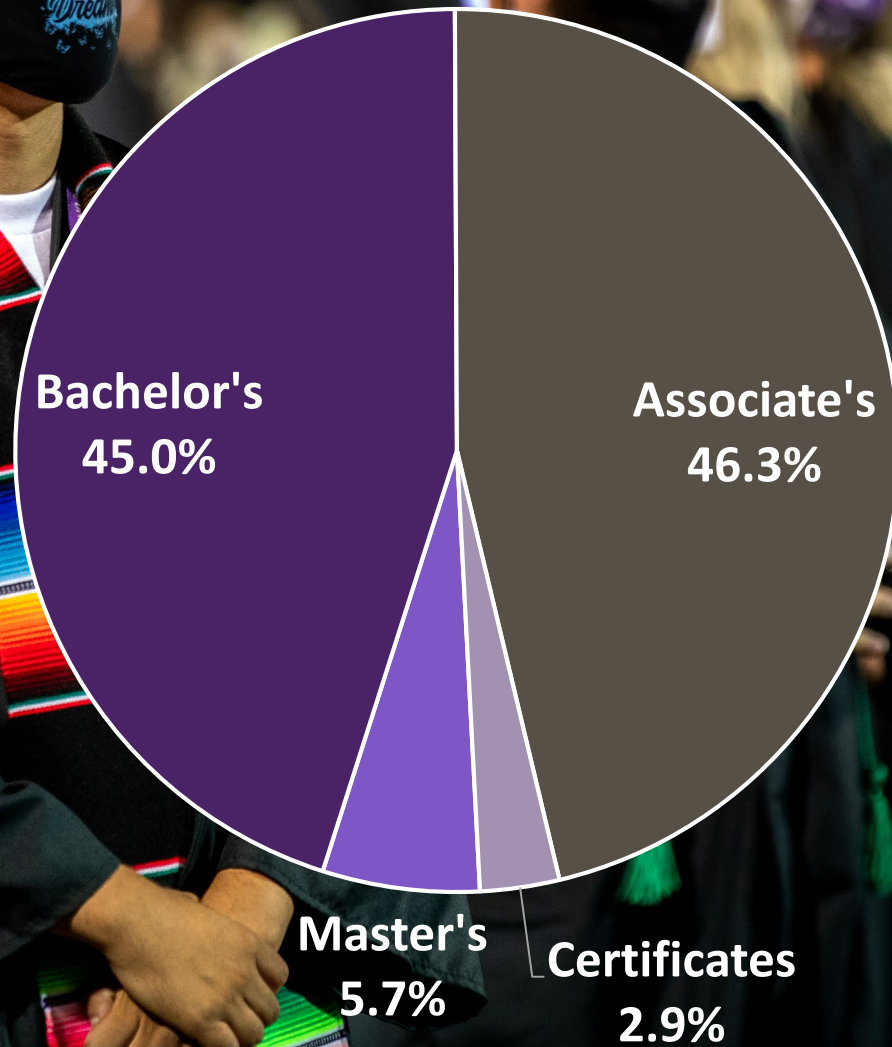

2019-20 Degrees by Type

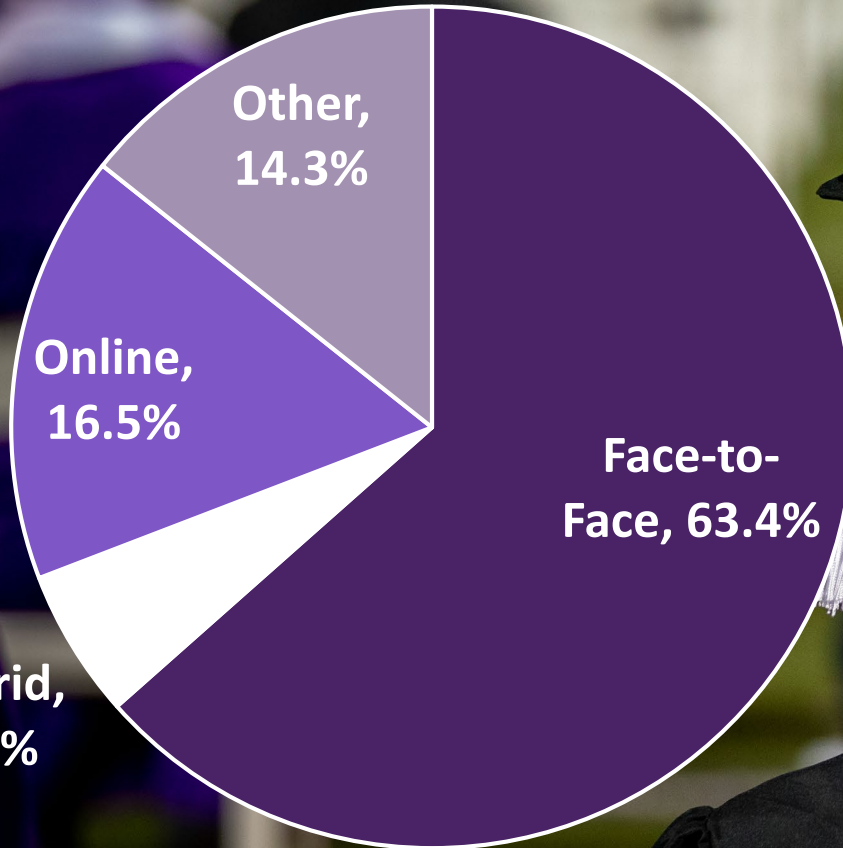

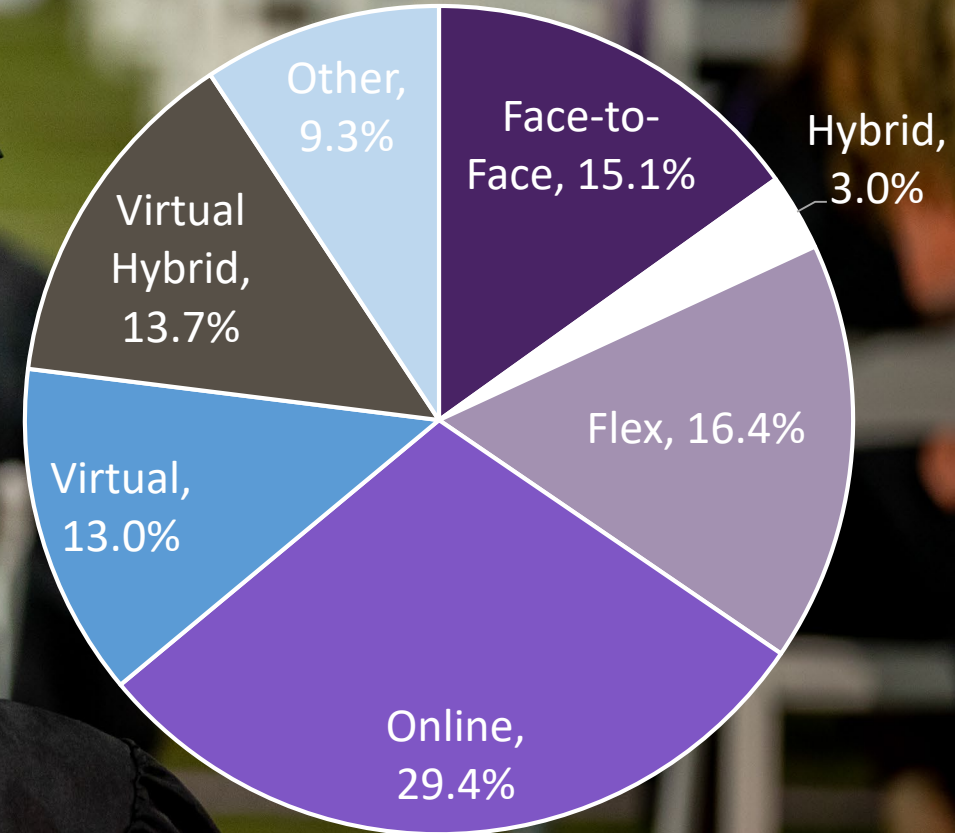

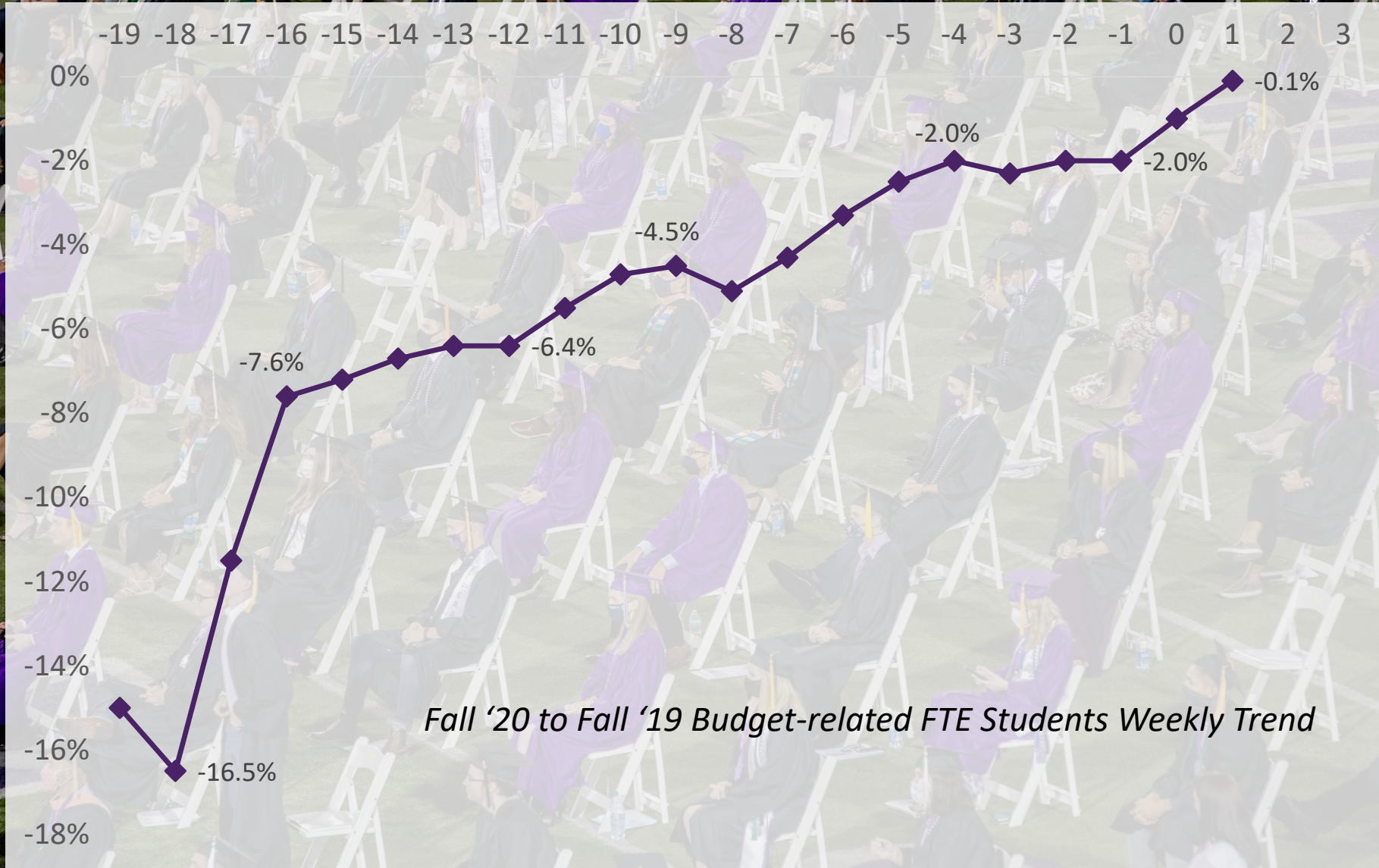

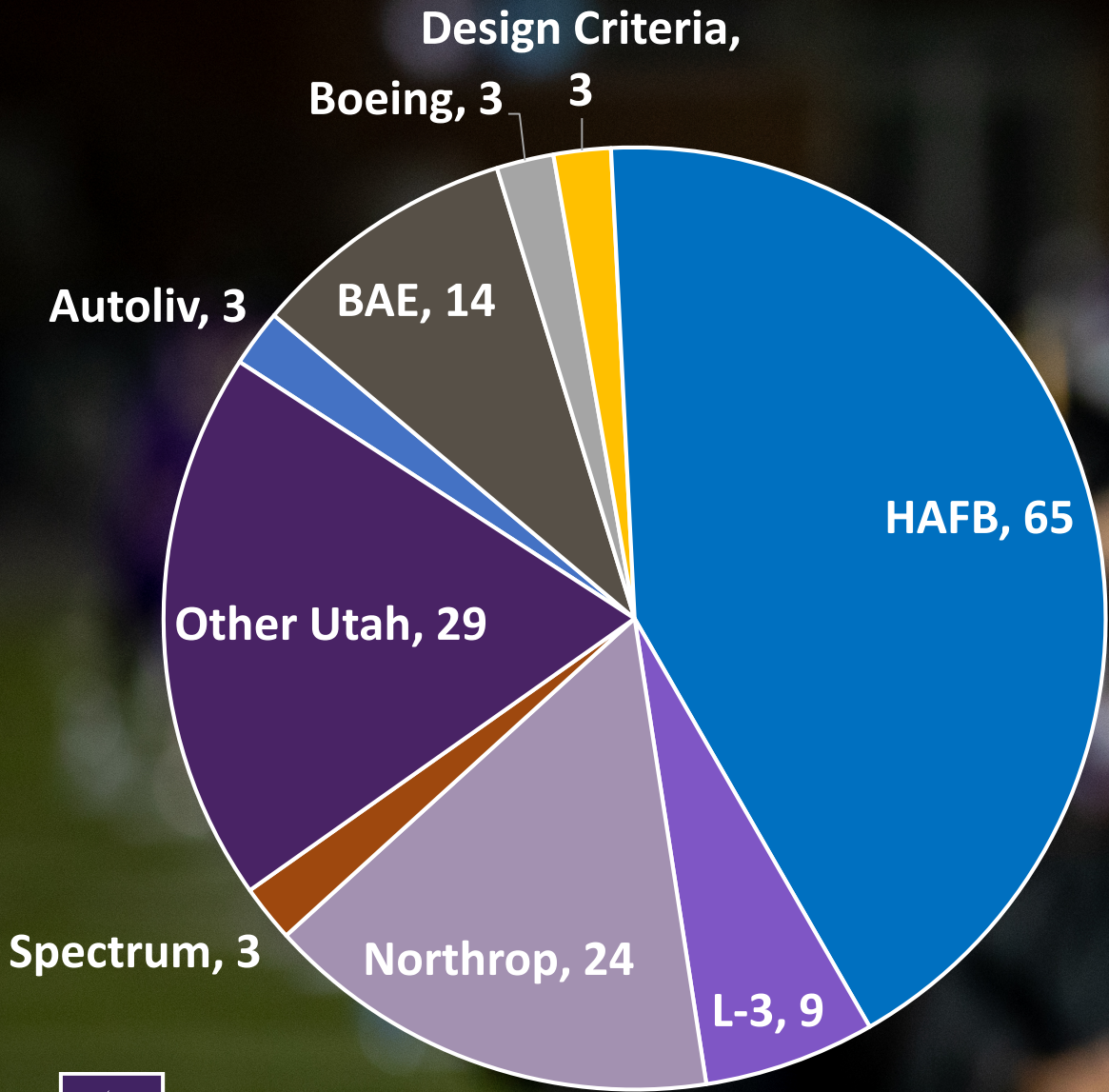
Fall Course Delivery Methods
