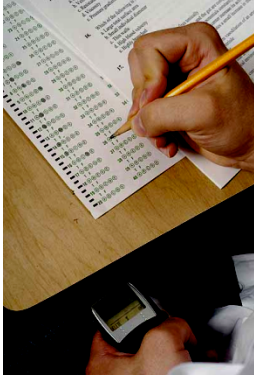


You know what happens when they cheat in your class...

This way, in addition to the course sanctions applied by the instructor, additional university-level sanctions may be applied. These sanctions may include probation, suspension, or expulsion. - Student name and W#
- Date of the incident
- Instructor name
- Course name
- Very brief description of the incident (i.e., plagiarism, collusion, use of unauthorized aid, etc.)
- Course sanction (i.e., failed exam, reduced grade on assignment, failed course, etc.)
