Project PRIME (Preparing Research-based Inclusive Multidisciplinary Educators) is an IDEA Personnel Preparation grant through the Utah State Office of Education. The major objectives of Project PRIME are: (a) recruit cohorts of paraprofessionals and teachers working on emergency Letters of Authorization who serve students with mild-moderate high-incidence disabilities in Northern Utah, (b) expand outreach capabilities of the WSU Special Education Licensure Program, (c) deliver program coursework in the use of research-validated instructional practices, and (d) evaluate the effectiveness of the project and disseminate the results at state and national conferences. Dr. Fran Butler served as project director until her retirement in May 2014. I



served as assistant director from 2007 – 2009 and 2012 – 2014, and then assumed the position of project director in June 2014. Dr. Patrick Leytham now serves as assistant project director.
