- Must be ready for Math and English 1010 to begin Zoology program.
- Each of eight breadth requirements must be from a different program.
- Complete one breadth general education courses that also meets the diversity requirement
- **Meet with an academic adviser** to create a specialized plan that fits your needs.
- **Credit-hour (CH) requirements: 120 ch total; 40 ch of upper-division credit (≥3000 level)**
- Complete *at least 15 credit hours per semester* for efficient progress to graduation.
