** (Minimum of 3 credits required, but students could complete up to an additional 3 credits)
3. RHS 4800 – Individual Projects (1 credit) – Note: Students will receive 3 experiential credits of RHS 4800 as part of the MSAT program, but could take one additional credit within their undergraduate program)

5. PEP 3280 - Methods of Teaching Strength and Conditioning Credits: (3)
6. ESS 4370 - Clinical Exercise Physiology Credits: (3)

8. PSY 3600 - Statistics in Psychology Credits: (3) (recommend taking PSY 3605 in the same semester)

9. NUTR 4520 - Directed Undergraduate Nutrition Research Credits: (1-4)
10. HLTH 3400 - Substance Abuse Prevention Credits: (3)
11. MICR 3603 - Advanced Microbiology for the Health Professions Credits: (3)
12. PSY 3000 - Child Psychology Credits: (3)
13. PSY 3010 - Abnormal Psychology Credits: (3)
14. ZOOL 3099 - Teaching the Human Anatomy Laboratory Credits: (3) and/or
ZOOL 4820 - Human Physiology Laboratory Teaching Assistant Credits: (1)
Note: These are typically reserved for students to completed ZOOL 2100 and 2200.
