Why Dual Enrollment?

- LOW TUITION FEES

Students who complete 12 credit hours of dual enrollment with a 3.0 GPA receive a \$2,000 per year tuition waiver! (the GPA requirement only looks at their dual enrollment GPA...not their overall high school GPA)

QUESTIONS? jennifervesper@weber.edu When your student enrolls in a Dual Enrollment course, they receive their required credits for high school graduation. The same course also gives them university credits that can help them earn career credentials while still in high school.

Students take university level classes at their high school from high school faculty members who are certified by WSU to be qualified adjunct faculty. Students will be admitted to Weber State University and will need to register for each course. We will begin this process during school hours, but it requires a payment, so most students will complete the admissions and registration process at home. Please ask them about it!

Dual Enrollment students can earn up to 30 credits in one academic year. Your student has the ability to graduate with their Automotive Service Technology Certificate from Weber State University before high school graduation.

If you have the first 5 courses plus any two of the three suggested courses, you will earn your certificate of proficiency upon high school graduation. You will also be eligible for the Edge Scholarship with a 3.0 GPA in just these classes.

NOTE - not all courses are offered at every high school. Please check with your counselor for availability.
