# ACDelco Future Technician Scholarship Program

A scholarship program for high school seniors

### ACDelco Future Technician Scholarship Program 2009

#### Background

The ACDelco Future Technician Scholarship Program has been developed by GM Service and Parts Operations. The program is designed to help high school seniors with their first-year expenses at an accredited vocational school, trade school, college or university. A limited number of \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded in 2009. Scholarships will be distributed in one payment of \$1,000.

#### Eligibility

To be considered for an ACDelco Future Technician Scholarship, applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- A student currently completing the senior year of high school with sufficient credits to graduate in the spring term of 2009
- Possess a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- Have demonstrated both academic excellence as well as outstanding community service through activities volunteerism and work experiences
- Completed 6 of 12 technical training courses
- Be attending an accredited two- or four-year college, university, trade or vocational school on a full-time basis (12 or more semester hours) in the fall term of 2009
- Be a citizen of the United States or have eligibility to permanently work in the United States.

#### Selection Criteria

Applicants will be evaluated on the strength of their personal statement, demonstrated interest in a career as an automotive technician or other closely related job in the automotive industry, academic performance, leadership skills, and participation in school and community activities.

#### Selection Procedure

In 2009, all completed applications that are postmarked no later than March 31, 2009 will be reviewed against the program criteria by a selection process determined by the General Motors Scholarship Administration Center. All applicants will receive written notification of the selection committee decision in May. Decisions are final and binding. #### **Application Instructions**

- Read the application carefully and complete all sections.
  - Be sure to include a typed 500 750 word personal statement expressing how your experiences academics, activities and work experiences have shaped your educational and career goals including your interest in a career in the automotive aftermarket or related automotive industry. You may also include any financial need or other information you wish to share that may be of importance to the selection committee in their review of your application.
- A signed letter of recommendation from a teacher or school administrator on official letterhead.
- Include or request to have sent an official transcript.
- Sign the last page of the application.
- Copies of your 6 course completion certificates.
- Mail completed application to the GM Scholarship Administration Center at the address on the application form. All applications must be postmarked no later than March 31, 2009.
