Latinxs account for 43% of COVID-19 cases in the Weber-Morgan Health Department



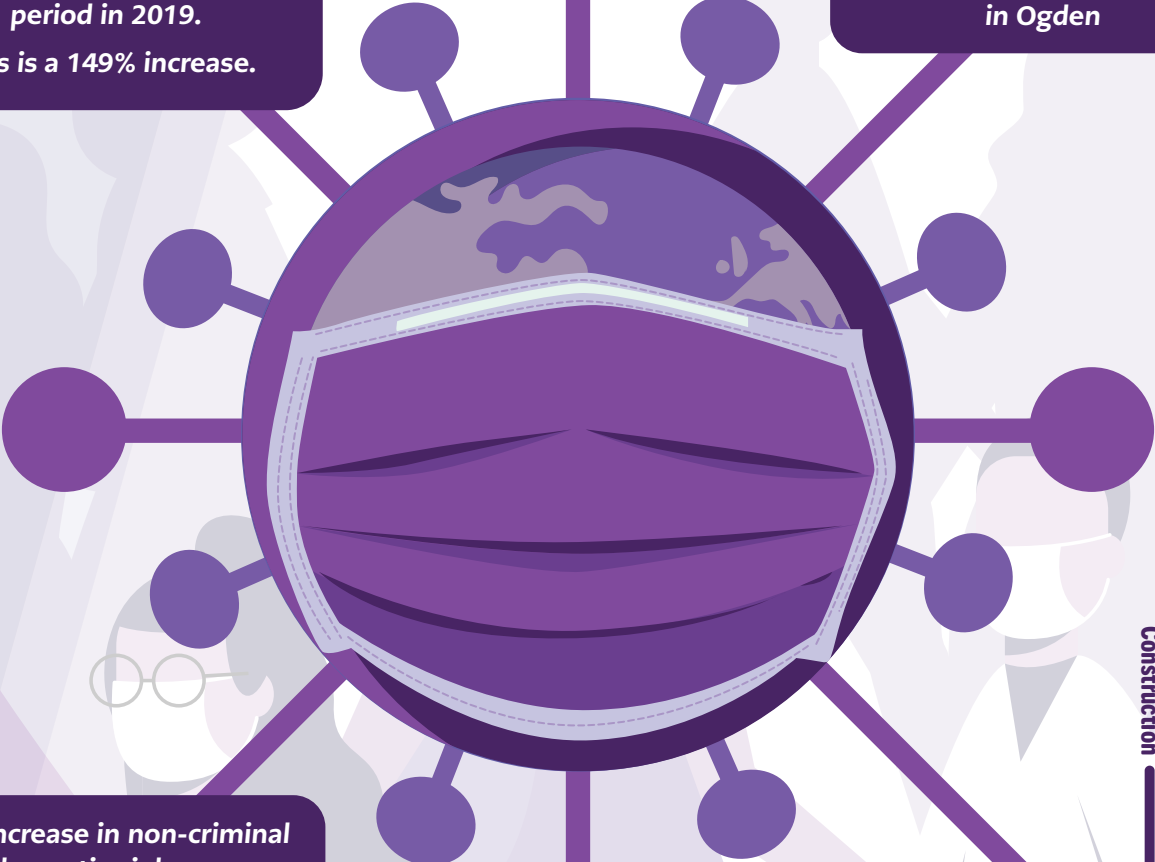
EVICCTIONS

211 PUBLIC ASSISTANCE CALLS

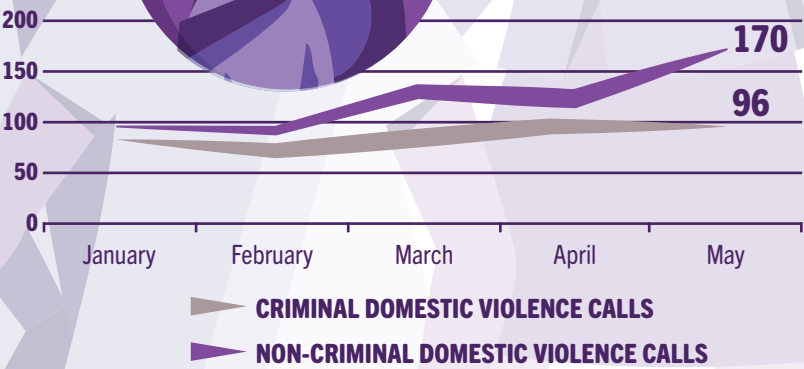
An increase of 355 calls to 211 for rent assistance as compared to the same period in 2019. This is a 149% increase.

The unemployment rate in Weber County has more than tripled since March from 3.4% to 10.7%

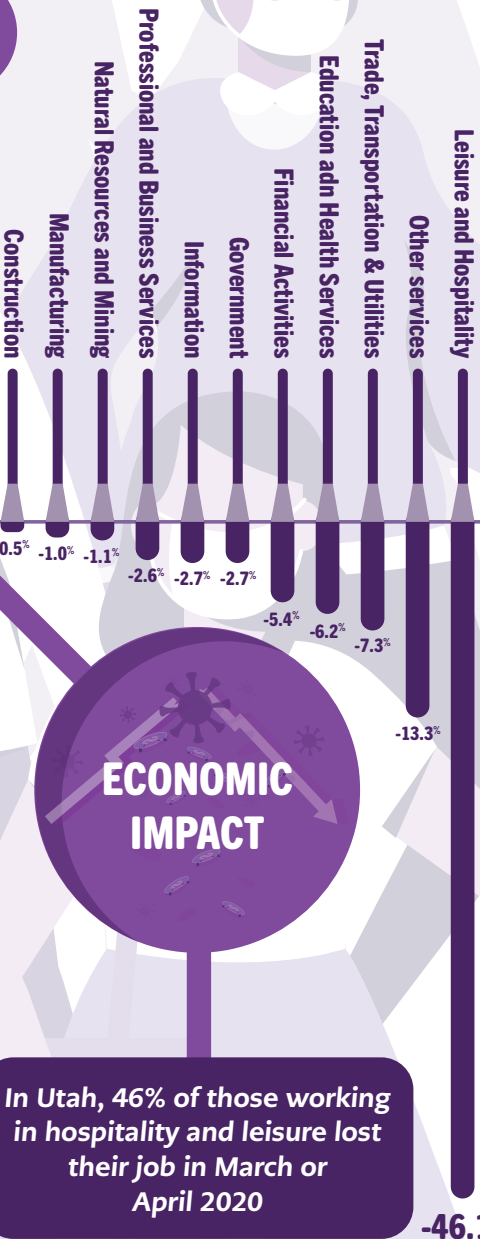
