By submitting this application form, I understand and agree to satisfactorily completing the following BIS Degree requirements. I also consent to the BIS department monitoring my progress as I complete my degree.

- The attached academic contract must be completed and signed by all three departmental authorized faculty advisers.
- Courses which are used to satisfy Gen. Ed. may **not** be included in a BIS area of emphasis and all classes must be letter graded.
- A 2.5 GPA is required for admissions into the BIS program; admitted students must maintain an overall 2.5 GPA in order to graduate with a BIS degree. Individuals who do not meet this requirement will have one academic semester to raise their GPA. Failure to do so will result in the students' BIS admissions being revoked.
- All required courses for the BIS program (emphasis, capstone work) must have a letter grade of C or higher. Grades below a C are unacceptable.
- All WSU institutional graduation requirements must be completed, including 40 upper division hours as part of 120 total semester credit hours.
- BIS 3800 (Preparation for the BIS Capstone) is a prerequisite for BIS 4800.
- BIS 4800 (Capstone Project) is 3 hours of upper division credits earned while writing the capstone project.
