It is important that students take CHF 2610 Guidance based on Development Theory as prerequisite of CHF 2620 Planning Creative Experiences for Young Children. Concepts learned in the CHF 2610 course provide an important foundation for the CHF 2620 course. Both CHF 2610 and CHF 2620 have practicum requirements in the WSU Children's School. Students who have taken both courses concurrently have struggled to demonstrate optimal performance in both courses and often lack the competencies required to be successful in the Early Childhood Education and Elementary Education majors. Thus, students should take the courses sequentially rather than simultaneously.

In rare occasions, students have extenuating circumstances that make it difficult to take CHF 2610 and CHF 2620 sequentially. In such cases (e.g., job transfers, childbirth, military service, religious missionary service, transfer from another university, etc.), students have a need to take the courses simultaneously.
