___ Is your college/university overall cumulative GPA at least **3.0**?

___ To be eligible to apply, you must be able to check **all** support courses from the one of the two Track options listed below, showing you have completed the courses with a grade of '**C**' or **higher**. *All courses within the required support course must be completed or in progress prior to starting the Rehabilitation Sciences program:*

___ To be eligible to apply, you must complete the following Rehab Science courses with a grade of '**B-**' or **higher**. *These RHS courses must be completed prior to acceptance into the RHS program.*

___ RHS 1550 Introduction to Rehabilitation Sciences (2)

___ RHS 2175 Introduction to Sports Medicine (3)

___ RHS 2890 Introduction to Cooperative Work Experience (1)

___ RHS 1300 First Aid/CPR; or RHS 2300 Emergency Response;

Or EMT Certificate: PAR 1000 (4) and PAR 1001 (2)

***Selection should be based on your pre-professional graduate program of interest.*

___ Math Quantitative Literacy Level Recommendation:

___ We highly recommend that you meet the Math 1050 QL or Math 1080 QL requirement.

Both are prerequisites options for many graduate/pre-professional programs. This option is determined by the graduate program you are seeking.

___ ACT Math Score of 23 or higher.

___ Accuplacer College Level Math (CLM) core of 50 or higher within the last year

(Be aware that certain graduate programs may require a Math grade or other courses past Math 1050 QL.)
