Data Pulse: Fall 2025 Enrollment and Retention Update

WSU Data is excited to announce that total enrollment for the Fall 2025 semester has grown to **33,293 students**, representing a **1.8% increase** over Fall 2024 and **surpassing our Strategic Plan goal of 32,000 students**. WSU saw increases in a number of student populations, including a **3.1% increase** in concurrent enrollment students, a **4.8% increase** in continuing students, and a **2.5% increase** in resident, first-time students over Fall 2024. In line with national trends, we saw a 14.6% decline in international student enrollment.

Student success indicators also show encouraging progress. Our retention rate for first-time, degree-seeking students increased by **0.5 percentage points** from last year, reaching **58.7%**—just shy of our Strategic Plan goal of 60%.

This success is a reflection of the **dedication and hard work** of our faculty, staff, and campus partners who continue to create an environment where students can thrive. Together, we are advancing student success and building a welcoming and supportive community for our students.

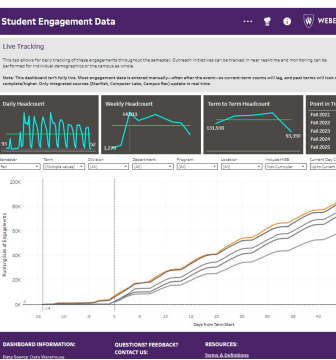

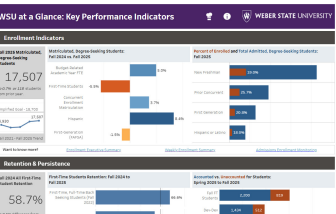
Report Gallery Highlights

Updated Student Engagement Dashboard



This comprehensive reporting tool tracks and analyzes student participation in engagement activities across campus. It consolidates data from multiple sources to provide real-time and historical insights into how, when, and where students interact with programs, services, and departments. This **dashboard** has been updated to include live tracking of engagements, non-engaged student data, and a new Crossover Engagement tab showing which activities the same students often participate in.

Key Performance Indicators (KPI) Dashboard Renewal



Rather than retiring the **KPI dashboard**, WSU Data has given it a refresh to better serve campus leaders. The revamped dashboard shows high level summaries of trends in enrollment, retention, and graduation broken down by key demographics, empowering leaders to make data-informed strategic decisions.

WSU Data Literacy Program in the Spotlight

Weber State’s **Data Literacy Program** has been selected as an exemplar of Building Institutional Capacity for Data Literacy in the **2025 EDUCAUSE Horizon Report | Data & Analytics Edition**, showcasing efforts by the WSU Data team and campus partners to foster a data-informed culture. This highlight recognizes our commitment to empowering all faculty and staff to use data effectively.



Data In Action: Using Data to Respond to Real-Time Needs



To support the university’s requirement that all first-time students complete **both orientation and an academic advising session**, Weber State’s New Student Orientation (NSO) team is **harnessing real-time data to personalize the onboarding experience**.

Using new, orientation-specific data tools, the team can identify emerging trends and respond immediately to student needs. This summer, for instance, data revealed a surge of interest in **General Studies and the Dumke College of Health Professions**. In response, the team added targeted advising events tailored to those academic areas.

The system also tracks student progress post-orientation, enabling timely outreach to those who haven’t yet registered for classes. These nudges reinforce a sense of belonging and contribute to stronger enrollment outcomes.

Since WSU started mandatory advising in NSO in Fall 2024, we saw a **1.3% increase** in retention of first-time students who completed NSO, meaning we were able to retain **47 more students** than expected under this initiative. This work reflects Weber State’s commitment to enhancing the student experience —meeting learners where they are and guiding them toward success.
