
HS SENIOR CHECKLIST



FOR **DUAL ENROLLMENT STUDENTS**



1.COMPLETE CONFIRMATION OF INTEREST FORM



Every high school senior in the Davis, Morgan, Ogden and Weber School Districts plus NUAMES High Schools is automatically admitted through direct admissions and will receive an official admission letter in the mail.

Fill out the Confirmation of Interest Form and select Weber State at weber.edu/direct

Only seniors outside of the mentioned school districts or those not eligible for direct admission who participated in Concurrent Enrollment may still utilize the "Status Switch" process in the eWeber portal.



2. COMPLETE THE FAFSA (Opens Oct. 1st, 2025)
