## Scholarship Information

### *Early College Scholarships*

WSU Early College academic scholarships are available to help off-set tuition for eligible students during the fall and spring semesters. Scholarships are contingent upon funding and may be reviewed each semester. You **MUST** re-apply each year and maintain a 3.25 WSU GPA in order to receive scholarship monies. A limited amount of Early College need-based scholarship funds may also be available.

### *Eligibility Requirements*

To be eligible to participate in Early College, you must be the equivalent of a high school sophomore, junior or senior and have an ACT score of at least 23 or an SAT score of at least 1070 (SAT critical reading and mathematics scores only). Sophomores will be limited in their registration.

### *Academic Scholarships*

A limited number of academic scholarships will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis upon completion of Early College application steps and grade seniority.

Applications available: Sept. 1

To be considered for the scholarship, students need to be registered for classes by:

May 1 for Fall; Dec. 1 for Spring

### *Need-Based Scholarships*

A limited number of need-based scholarships will be awarded based on essay and evidence of financial need.

Applications and documentation due:

Aug. 1 for Fall; Dec. 1 Spring
