2. Administrative Update for Faculty Senate - Norm Tarbox

Starts by saying he is not going to explain anything about the administrative structure reorganization change. Explained that it is the biggest change that has happened in 25 years. It is focused on aligning the programs to the strategic plan. It is focused on serving the students better and there will be a town hall next Tuesday.

Second thing I want to mention is talk about enrollment and budget cuts. Tuition is down and enrollment is down, some are between 1- 2 % depending on how the summer term goes.

This has a direct effect on Weber state's finances. One to 2% decline in enrollment is significant, so all divisions are facing budget cuts. At the same time, the University is expecting a significant amount of additional funding from the legislature. Every dollar that is given to us is earmarked for a specific area. So for the second year in a row, the University will be in a position of having to add resources. This is why the focus on students and retention and success. The need is to start growing to remain fiscally healthy.

Next mentioned Black History month and the keynote Speaker for Black History Month will be Chairman Fred Hampton, Jr. of the Black Panther cubs. He will be speaking on campus February 20, 2023.

For the Education building the plan was to do a total gut and renovation of Education almost exactly like we did here in Lindquist Hall. The University had to ask for another chunk of money to complete the building due to costs going up and inflation. Will not know until the beginning of March if we will get the additional funding from the legislature.
