3. Administrative Update - Betsy Mennell & Ravi Krovi

IT will be requiring DUO use by students on Feb 16, 2024 and there may be a fee for students if they need some accommodations for the token. But if students do not have the means it will be waived. During March there will be a google migration, this will cause some outages in the system.

Legislative sessions are still currently ongoing. Ravi will address the one bill relating to tenure. HB 261 is the Equal Opportunity Initiatives, this bill has been signed and is dealing with diversity. The university has started to look at these bills carefully while comparing it to the PPM. There is no need to worry about cuts as we are looking through the bill and the changes that need to be made. The university has started looking at ways to adjust that will address the changes that will need to happen here on campus.

In 2021 the 6 year graduation rate was 26%. In 2024 it is in the 40%, and the persistence is doing very well. WSU was ranked in the top 50 public schools in the west.

HB 438 Higher Education Revisions including section on tenure. There have been a lot of people working behind the scenes trying to modify the policy by changing some of the verbiage. In line 108, the first problem has been removed from the bill it dealt with faculty property, the second section was on dismissal, 135-145 is almost the same as what we have in PPM 9-12 the one difference is that the PPM says 12 months, USHE says that it should align with WSU PPM. Annual faculty Review needs to be done yearly. Post tenure review will be done.

Line 166 states there will be student evaluations for all courses being taught. A lot of the language is in the PPM already.

Questions for Ravi: Is the biggest change going to be the annual teaching review? yes but also think post tenure review will be significant.

A lot of states have done this elsewhere and are we worried about the changes out of the other states? Response was I am worried about where this can go based on what is happening in other states.

Do we have an advocate on the details of the hiring? Do the members of the legislature know what we do and what this industry is? Response: No, most people do not understand tenure, but believe that the Utah System of Higher Education (USHE) is trying to represent higher education. One thing is that it doesn't have anything on program discontinuance. Would like for the changes coming forward to address the change in not being able to guarantee the positions.
