There were two meetings this month and we had to vote to extend it multiple times.

There are 173 proposals coming forward. New programs, new courses, and substantive changes.

Bachelor University Studies was proposed and there was a lot of debate on this degree. The plan was to vote over email and move it out for a vote twice due to a breach of Robert's rules. The proposals did not pass. Some of things that were concerning to members were that rigor, BIS was not supportive of the proposals, and the parameters and thresholds. Discussion on the degree and that it will probably come up in the senate.

There was a proposal that was in Electrical Engineering that involved a lot of going back and forth about the inclusion of a Math course that was being dropped. The proposal passed to drop the course. Discussion about the proposal and how it will proceed.

The masters of physician studies program came through with a lot of changes. There may be questions about the clarity. The students are on campus M-F all day. The committee had them add additional information.

The Manufacturing Engineering courses had some changes in the emphasis.

An endorsement for Secondary Mathematics Teaching Certificate may be unclear to students that it does not licensure.

Materials Science post bacc certificate did not reach out to physics and chemistry and needed for the program to work.

There was a question on Occupational Therapy (OT) about why it was not an associates degree. It was created this way to allow for students to graduate with a bachelor's degree allowing the student to go straight to an OT school rather than returning back to get a degree.
