The most important thing is to find 8-10 professional schools you interested in, see what they require and work backwards. Make yourself an amazing applicant for those schools rather than being a good applicant for many.

We recommend that students job shadow in preparation for an OTA or OTR (graduate) program. Students will complete 6 job shadow hours in OTA 1010 course. Some graduate programs require 75-3000+ job shadow hours. It is important to know what your preferred programs require. Each program will have their own

requirements.
