Fall Semester (August)	March 15-May 15
Spring Semester (January)	July 15-September 15
Summer Semester (May)	November 15-January 15

Minimum Requirements for Application

- **GPA:** 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA from all higher education institutions
- **Prerequisite Courses:** Completed or enrolled in all prerequisite courses at the time of application. A minimum of a “C” grade is required.
- **International Students:** Must have a minimum English proficiency score within two (2) years of the program start date.

TOEFL iBT: **4.5 or higher** (taken after 1/21/2026); **86 or higher** (taken before 1/21/2026)

IELTS academic: **7 or higher** DUOLINGO English Test: **120 or higher**

Only materials uploaded to the application by the deadline will be considered for review. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure all courses (completed and in progress) are reflected in the transcripts uploaded to the application. Any courses not documented on the transcripts uploaded with the application documents will not be considered.

Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) or Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

A CNA or EMT is not required to apply, but an active certificate is required before the program starts. Applicants with proof of **current** certification at the time of application will receive additional application consideration. Military medical background within the last 2 years (DD-214) may fulfill the requirement.

Required Prerequisite Courses

Applicants must have completed or be enrolled in all prerequisite courses at the time of application submission. All prerequisite courses must be completed with a **grade of ‘C’ or higher** prior to the start of the program if admitted. Additional consideration awarded based on grades received in the courses.

- HTHS 2110 - Integrated Anatomy and Physiology I **OR** Zoology 2320 - Human Anatomy
- HTHS 2111- Integrated Anatomy and Physiology II **OR** Zoology 2420 - Human Physiology
- Chemistry 1130 and CHEM 1135 - Introduction to General, Organic, and Biochemistry
 - Chemistry 1110 and 1115 **OR** Chemistry 1210 and 1215 may be substituted
- Quantitative Literacy – Math 1030, 1035, 1040, 1050, **OR** 1080

Additional Support Courses/General Education

These courses are **not required** for admission; however, students may complete these courses for additional application consideration. Additional consideration is awarded if **all courses** are completed with grades posted at the time of application. Students will not receive additional application consideration for a completed degree or certificate.

- English 1010 (3 credits)
- English 2010 (3 credits)
- PSY 1010 (SS) **or** CHF 1500 (SS/CC) (3 credits)
- Humanities HU (3 credits)
- Creative Arts CA (3 credits)
- American Institutions AI (3 credits)
- Cultural Competence CC (3 credits)

Bonus Support Courses

These courses are **not required** for admission; however, students may complete these courses for additional application consideration. Additional consideration is awarded per course completed based on grades received. Courses must have a grade of “C” or higher to receive application consideration.

HTHS 2230 - Pathophysiology
MICR 1113 – Introductory Microbiology

Transfer courses to Weber

It is recommended that students [apply to Weber State](#) to become a student and submit all transcripts from prior institutions to determine the transferability of courses.

- Start with prerequisites
- Complete support courses and general education
- Current CNA/EMT
- Complete bonus courses
- Apply once qualified and continue to apply
- Increase grades in prerequisites and bonus courses to increase GPA and application consideration.
