Step 1: Admissions

- ☐ Graduated in 2025 or later from Davis, Morgan, Ogden, or Weber School Districts: Complete the [Confirmation of Interest Form](#).
- ☐ Weber State Concurrent Enrollment (outside those districts): Submit the [Status Switch application](#) in eWeber.
- ☐ All other students: [Apply for admission](#) to Weber State University.

Step 2: Send Transcripts & Test Credit

- ☐ Request official transcripts from any college/university you've attended.
- ☐ AP/CLEP/other exams: Send official scores to WSU and submit the [Test Credit Application](#).

Step 3: Orientation & Advising
